Reports:

Draft Minutes of May 3rd meeting were reviewed and on **MOTION** of KD6XH, Second of KE7IDC with no dissenting, were approved as published.

Treasurer's Report unavailable, full reports at annual meeting.

Chairman's report: KD70ED spoke to availability of WB6OTS and offered combined reports. Rumor of Hamfest in Lake Havasu City was founded, a small event was held on California side of which Arizona side was unaware. WB6OTS has contacts for Williams, need for scheduled transportation to off site lectures repeated. Porta-Potties and VE yet to be finalized. Expect help from Coconino club, their recent ISS contact noted.

Second Vice-Chairman's Report: KE6JUK reviewed Williams grounds, Railside, Chamber, Kiwanis, etc... en-route to this meeting; reports grounds in great condition but rodeo is week prior to hamfest, expect some clean-up will be needed.

Frequency Coordination: No representative in attendance.

Section Managers Report: K7DF reported on state activities. SW Division Director has not yet approved Yuma Hamfest 2013 as ARRL SW Division Convention as referenced in February, neither N6AA or N6VI responding. ARRL will be auditing National Repeater Directory, may mean changes to National Frequency Coordinators Council operations. January Quartz-fest (Jan 15-25) expected to grow up to 60% in 2013.

OLD BUSINESS:

ARCA Branding: New banner prepared by the Chairman was on display today. ARCA logo digitization has been completed. Stencil being investigated.

Ham of the Year; three nominations received and being processed; Past Chair will have award prepared.

Insurance options have been investigated by Treasurer; original carrier will be retained for liability coverage 2012-2013. Property coverage being re-evaluated following discovery with new carrier. Options with ARRLs' Hays to be readdressed.

NEW BUSINESS:

ARCA Meeting Schedule: Options discussed as to lessening number of meetings. Only required is Summer Hamfest Annual meeting. Number of meetings has been increasing over last 20-25 years to assist in promoting statewide events, but has had a negative effect on participation. Survey of attendance records over last five years shows Annual meeting is best attended (avg 21), followed by Winter (avg 20) Spring (avg 17) and 'Special' meetings (avg 14), others much lower. Fall fest (avg 9) would keep meeting in Tucson area. Also repeated concerns from representatives to hold meetings earlier as they don't want to stay late at a hamfest; hold meetings later as they don't want to meet during hamfest time; meet on Sundays as Saturdays are busy; don't meet on Sunday as travel time interferes with services; etc... In distant past all meetings except Summer were held at a central location without co-location at another event. All will not be happy or available whichever the choice. Cost to delegates/board to attend at frequent and varied locations statewide can be limiting. Important to have a formal presence and be accessible at as many events as possible, but could be accomplished by an individual and not an under-attended formal meeting. Further discussion and vote at July 21st meeting.

Elections: KD6XH presented a slate of officers for 2012-2013, noting that many who were approached felt they could not serve. Current Chair is eligible to serve one more year but would prefer to take past-chair position; Past Chair is willing to continue with anticipation of less physical involvement. 1st Vice-Chair, 2nd Vice-Chair, and Secretary all reach term limits and must be replaced at this election. Member clubs must present nominees on meeting floor or in advance to KD6XH@arrl.net.

Call for any additional business before the Council went unanswered.
