

ARCA Annual Meeting Minutes Flagstaff Hamfest June 14, 2025

Call to Order: The meeting was called to order by Chair Charlie Zurenko/N2TFS at 11:35 AM. The meeting was delayed from its planned start at 11:00 AM because of a scheduling issue with the auditorium that required the Repeater Owners Committee meeting to be held at 11:00 and a subsequent technical issue with internet access. A sign-in sheet was circulated for in-person attendees, and on-line attendees were recorded in the ZOOM call. A total of 57 people attended either in-person or via ZOOM representing 37 different Arizona member amateur clubs, the ARRL, and the ARCA staff.

Chair's Report, Charlie Zurenko/N2TFS: Charlie welcomed all to the ARCA annual meeting and thanked the NADX association for putting on a great hamfest and noted that most attendees appreciated the ability to go from the hall to the swapfest parking lot without having to go up and down a set of stairs. It has been his privilege to serve as the ARCA chair for the past 3 years but he looks forward to the election of a new chair later today. He encouraged ARCA clubs and delegates to run for positions in the coming years as there is lots of work to be done.

First Vice-Chair's Report, Rick Aldom/W7STS: Rick reviewed upcoming hamfests and advised the group the list is available on the ARCA website. Additionally, the Yuma Hamfest and SW Division Convention will be February 27-28, 2026.

Second Vice-Chair's Report, Brian McCarthy/AK7F: Brian has completed the annual equipment inventory of ARCA assets. The gear has been reorganized, and the trailer is stored at his house. He also noted that he has put forward a proposal to acquire a new Owl camera as a way of replacing some of the other outdated AV equipment that we have – the proposal will be discussed later under new business.

Secretary's Report, Janice Enloe/KI6WCK: Janice was absent as she was in the process of moving out of state. Past Chair Lee Ilse/K7OED noted that there were three minor corrections to Janice' draft minutes from the April meeting at the Red Cross, and the corrected version had been emailed to all clubs. Dave Hall/N7ZPY moved to accept the minutes as amended. The motion was seconded by Mike Boger/W7IJ. There was no discussion, and the motion passed by a voice vote.

Treasurer's Report, Chris Kesauer/N7PVL: Chris apologized that she was unable to display the report to the online members because of network difficulties in the room, but the report is posted in the Dropbox for all to review, but gave the report as of June 7, 2025.

Checking account: The initial balance of \$33,639.03 as of April 12,2025. Income of \$5,816.59 included a transfer from the Scholarship Account and a \$50 donation from Fry's Foods. If you shop at Fry's have a Fry's card, you can designate ARCA as the beneficiary of a portion of their donation fund at no cost to you. We had expenses including disbursal of \$4902.96 of license plate funds to member clubs, \$500 for the UofA club grant, liability and equipment insurance cost of \$1,146.70 and other admin expenses for a total of \$6860.50. The checking account balance is \$32,595.12.

PayPal Cash flow: The PayPal account balance in April was \$3,507.74. We had membership income of \$20 from Yuma Auxiliary Communications Club and a \$0.89 fee for a revised balance of \$3,526.85.

Grant Fund: The April balance was \$23,986.30. We transferred \$500 to checking to pay the UofA club grant and had \$0.38 in interest income resulting in a revised balance of \$23,486.68.

Scholarship Fund: The April balance was \$5,532.98. We accrued interest of \$0.07, and transferred \$5,000 transfer to the checking account in anticipation for awarding our 2025 scholarship award. The revised balance is \$533.05.

Corporate Balance Sheet: Assets including cash and equipment equity totals \$61,868.97 with no liabilities.

Chris also stated that there are license plate fund checks that haven't been cashed yet, so please check the address that your club has on file to ensure the checks are going to the correct address. And finally, she noted that we have received a donation \$955 from the estate of Bob Burleson/KG7QJ (SK). This donation was received after the report was prepared so it will be included in the next quarterly report.

Past Chair's Report, Lee Ilse/K70ED: He stated that he had nothing else to cover that won't be covered under new business.

Frequency Coordinator's Committee Report: The committee held a short meeting immediately prior to the ARCA meeting. Items of note from that meeting are that Matt Lunati/N7OI is retaking the position of 6M coordinator, and Joe Godfrey/AE7JG is now the 440 coordinator. Chris Radicke/N7TWW has volunteered to take over 1.2 MHz because of the passing of Tom Sharp/WA9OXY but is still transitioning. Charlie Zurenko was elected to replace Lance Halle/KW7LH as the committee chair.

Old Business: Maricopa ARA Grant Request: During the April meeting Michael Mills/NO7S gave a presentation on the MARA grant request in the amount of \$1,500.00 to help fund amateur radio equipment for use by 4H club youth. The initiative is in partnership with both 4H and the University of Arizona Cooperative Extension Service. Due to the untimely death of the MARA president prior to the April meeting, the MARA club had not had an opportunity to address questions raised by the ARCA board. Since that time, MARA has answered most board questions and submitted a revised request in the amount of \$2,509.88. This revised request could not be approved at this meeting because it differed from the original that was briefed in April. Michael/N07S answered several questions from the floor about the intent and the amount of the request during discussion. Lee/K7OED moved to

approve the grant request in the original amount of \$1,500. The motion was seconded by Jerry/K1GJQ, and the motion passed with most in favor and only two opposed.

New Business: Brian/AK7F gave a presentation on the Owl integrated camera and audio system that has twice been used for ARCA meetings at the Arizona Red Cross. The system consists of a camera unit, an extension microphone, a wireless USB controller, and a carrying case. Total cost including shipping is \$1,640.06. The board recommends purchasing the system, but this is above the expenditure level that the board can approve. Motion by Chris/N7PVL seconded by Lee/K7OED to approve the purchase in an amount not to exceed \$1,650.00. Online members have noted that previous experience with the Owl system is much better than the existing A/V equipment that ARCA has been using the past few years. Several member clubs noted that this would have helped eliminate the problems we are experiencing during today's meeting. There was no further discussion, and the motion passed unanimously.

Scholarship Award Presentation: Charlie/N2TFS announced that this year's scholarship winner is Mr. Landon Gale/AI7HE of the Center for Amateur Radio Learning. Landon was not present, but Jerry/K1GJQ accepted the award on his behalf and will present the \$5,000 check to Landon at the next CARL meeting.

Ham/Young Ham of the Year Awards: Charlie/N2TFS noted that we had four nominations for Ham of the Year. They were:

Mr. John Braden, K7LKL, nominated by the Arizona Repeater Association

Ms. Sue Rogers, W7SKH, nominated by the SunLife ARC

Mr. James Wasson, N7ELL, nominated by the Scottsdale ARC

Mr. Jim Zimmerman, N6KZ, nominated by the Yavapai ARC

The nominations were reviewed and voted on by the last 11 Ham of the Year Winners. Sue Rogers was declared the winner, and although she was not present today, Charlie will arrange for a presentation at a SunLife club meeting.

Mr. Cameron Legan, KK7OLN was nominated by the Radio Society of Tucson as the Young Ham of the Year and was the only nomination. Cameron was not present, but Charlie will arrange with the RST club to present his award at an RST meeting.

Additional Youth Participation: Rick/W7STS noted that we had only single nominations for Young Ham of the Year and Scholarships this year. He requested that member clubs look for local schools where we may be able to bring in more youth participation and provide ideas to ARCA on how we can develop some tools for clubs to bring youth into the hobby. James/KJ7JHE said he has ideas and will forward them to the ARCA email address.

Annual Election of Officers: Charlie/N2TFS announced that he has reached his term limit after serving three years as ARCA chair, so he is unable to serve another term but will transition to the Past Chair position. ARCA Secretary Janice/KI6WCK is in the process of moving to Virginia and will also be unable to serve another term. Vice-Chairs Rick/W7STS and Brian/AK7F are not term limited

and able to serve another term in their current positions. The treasurer is appointed by the board and is not subject to vote. The following nominations were submitted during the April meeting:

Nominations for uncontested positions were approved by acclimation. A roll call vote of individual clubs was conducted for the 2nd Vice Chair position. After tallying the votes, Charlie announced that Brian/AK7F was re-elected to the 2nd Vice-Chair position. He congratulated all winners and thanked them for their willingness to devote their time and effort to serve ARCA.
